Colleen Glenney Boggs puts animal representation at the center of the making of the liberal American subject. species line produces a tension that is never fully regulated. Therefore, as both figures of radical alterity and the embodiment of biopolitics, animals are simultaneously exceptional and exemplary to the biopolitical state.
